

Final Affirmative Determination in the Countervailing Duty Investigation of Monomers and Oligomers from Taiwan

On January 22, 2026, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its final affirmative determination in the countervailing duty (CVD) investigation of monomers and oligomers from Taiwan.
